

This document details the roles and responsibilities of the "Four Ball Skipper" for each golf day. The Match day Organiser nominates 1 person from each four ball to be the coordinator for himself & his playing partners for the 18 holes on that day only. He will be expected to carry out the tasks listed below and liaise with the Match day Organiser before and after the golf.

Inform & Communicate

- Each 4 ball skipper must ensure his 4-ball is on the 1st tee at the allotted time.
- Inform each player of the features fines for the day.
- Inform each player of the competition holes (Nearest the pin etc.)
- Communicate the society's basic rules.
- Communicate back to Match day Organiser any positive or negative points.

Check & Collect

- Collect scorecard from every player.
- Check the scorecard is correctly filled in and signed. (Stroke play & Stableford scores)
- Collect the entire feature fine money for his 4 ball and pass to the Match Day Organiser.
- The last 4 ball skipper to pick up competition markers and return to the Match Day Organiser.
- Make the final decision on any golfing issues arising at any of the 18 holes.
- Return and cameras used on the day to the Match Day Organiser.
