Planning your Trip (Tips & Memory Joggers)

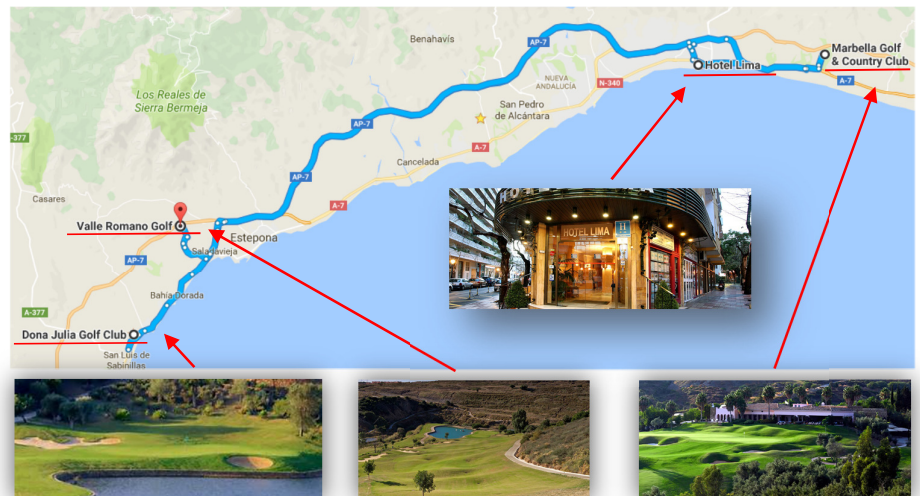
If Pete has booked your flights you will receive your boarding cards and details in your information pack at the airport. Please remember to pack your WGWC polo shirts Red or Blue for the final day. Other two days are WGWC preferred :-)

Make sure you have travel insurance to cover yourself & your golf equipment. Also check you have got your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) the replacement for the E111. This card entitles you to reduced cost, sometimes free, medical treatment in most European countries. Also remember to keep your hand luggage down to a minimal and there is only up to 20KG hold baggage per person. Note for those using Ryanair to return its 15KG Excess baggage will incur a charge per extra kilogram (use your golf bag for excess luggage, but remember that also has a 20KG limit) your golf clubs are separate to this we have each paid extra to transport these.

Do not forget to pack your golf shoes and take a hat, the sun will burn you even under cloud cover. Take plenty of golf balls as these can be expensive at the tourist courses.

Dress Code for Golf

Collared shirt with trousers or tailored shorts (with a zip/pocket & no cargo shorts) and knee or ankle socks (No trainer liners) it is advisable to take trousers with you to each golf day even if you are wearing shorts just in case the course does not like them. WGWC polo shirts are optional but preferred by the committee on the first two days but mandatory Blue or Red on Saturday's event.



Travel and Timing Details

1. Birmingham to Malaga Airport on to Hotel - Wednesday 13th

Travel in cars (arrange your own transfers) Meet at Birmingham airport in plenty of time to check in **no later** than **14:30** on Wednesday afternoon. (Please meet in the departure hall, as per other years to pick up your boarding passes) The flight is Monarch ZB974 departing at 16:55. Coach will pick us up from Malaga airport and take us to the hotel. Two guests will be joining us on the transfers to and from the airport. (Note: Dan Moore will arrive at around 23:50 from Luton)

2. Golf "Marbella Golf & Country Club" Course - Thursday 14th

All 21 golfers please meet in the hotel foyer for no later than **12:15** with golf clubs ready to be transported to Marbella Golf & Country Club. No food is arranged after golf, with the bus leaving at 19:30 back to the hotel. Please be washed and changed ready to meet for an evening meal around the marina. Pete will confirm meeting time and place.

3. Golf "Dona Julia" Course - Friday 15th

All 21 golfers please meet in the hotel foyer for no later than **12:00** with golf clubs ready to be transported to Dona Julia golf course. No food is arranged after golf, with the bus leaving at 19:30 back to the hotel. Please be washed and changed ready to meet for an evening meal around the marina. Pete will confirm meeting time and place after the golf.

4. Golf "Valle Romano" Course - Saturday 16th

All 21 golfers please meet in the hotel foyer no later than **12:00** with golf clubs ready to be transported to Valle Romano golf course. Food is arranged for 19:00, with the bus leaving at 20:30 back to the hotel. Please be washed and changed ready to meet for the evening festivities, Pete will confirm meeting time and place after the golf.

5. Free Day or Travel Home - Sunday 17th

Sunday is a free day for the majority of us. For those travelling home today (4 golfers - Jim Cunningham, Rob Ward, Paul Newsome & Rick Batchelor) please meet in the hotel foyer no later than 08:15 for a **08:20** pick up to Malaga airport. The coach will transfer you to Malaga Airport for the flights home Ryanair FR2157, departing Malaga at 11:20, arriving in Birmingham at 13:55 (Dan Moore will also leave Sunday morning. Hotel departure 07:30 for flight to Luton (Easy 2406)

6. Return to Malaga Airport for flight home - Monday 18th

The remaining golfers (plus 2 guests) please meet in the hotel foyer no later than 12:55 for a **13:00** pick up to Malaga airport. The coach will transfer us for our Norwegian Airlines D85006 flight at 16:30 back to Birmingham, arriving at 18:15.

The Golf

Marbella Golf & Country Club Thursday 14th

Tee Times 13:30, 13:40, 13:50, 14:00, 14:10, 14:20

Nearest the Pin on Holes 3rd & 16th - Captains Combo on Holes 7th, 11th & 17th
18 holes Course - 6061 yards Par 72

Designed by the legendary Robert Trent Jones Senior, and located just 5 minutes' drive from the cosmopolitan town of Marbella. Opened in 1994 and occupying one of the largest remaining green areas on the Costa del Sol, the 6.000 meter long 18-hole links course with a par of 72, has been imaginatively designed to respect the natural terrain. Our second visit to this course after the first one was cut short by 4 holes due to ownership issues. Course layout has been changed to give us a new challenge.

18 holes Course - 6172 yards Par 71



18-hole par 71 Parkland course designed by Antonio Garcia Garrido. The course is built under USGA specifications which makes it a fair test of golf. The course also has views over the Mediterranean Sea. The course offers two very different lay-outs, being suitable for any type of player. The front 9 is longer and more testing, winding between indigenous trees, lakes and rivers while the back 9 is more manageable, having a gentle incline, and being within a close proximity to the sea.

Valle Romano Saturday 16th

Nearest the Pin on Holes 11th & 13th - Captains Combo on Holes 6th, 9th & 16th
18 holes Course - 6134 yards Par 71

An exceptional 18-hole course, constructed to meet the highest quality standards used by the United States Golf Association, with a "TifSport" grass surface, certified by the University of Georgia, and a latest technology irrigation system. This course has been designed to be part of the European Tour. Its fairways can adapt to players of all levels and it has large greens. Cabell B. Robinson has designed a course that is located in the flattest part of the complex and goes from an elevation of 116 to one of 50
